## 1. Eligibility

- (1) Participants must have completed a 12 year educational curriculum.
- (2) Participants must have Japanese language proficiency equivalent to Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level N4 (Can use common daily conversation and read and write simple sentences. Level equivalent to having studied Japanese for 300 hours and completed a beginner's Japanese language course.)
- (3) In principle, participants must obtain their own visas.
- (4) Participants must be enrolled in overseas travelers' personal accident insurance which is valid during the period of the study.

## 3. Study Fees

- **3 or more person room usage (Dormitory) plan: 135,000 yen**

### Items included in study fees

Tuition; textbook costs; USJ, Kyoto, Osaka Castle field trip costs and transportation fees, exchange event, welcome party and graduation party. Accommodation rooms will be shared by 3~6 participants each. Rooms include kitchens, toilets and bathrooms. Contact us for separate consultation if you wish to use a single or twin room.

### Items not included in fees

Round trip airfare; round trip transportation to and from Kansai International Airport or other Airport; commuting costs from hotel to institution, overseas travel insurance (required); food costs during stay; other expenses incurred for personal activities; etc.

- **Accommodation Exclusive Plan (Participants are responsible for finding their own accommodations): 85,000 yen**

### Items not included in fees

Round trip airfare; hotel or other accommodation costs; round trip transportation to and from Kansai International Airport or other Airport; commuting costs from accommodations to institution, travel costs from accommodations to field trip meeting locations; overseas travel insurance (required); food costs during stay; other expenses incurred for personal activities; etc.

## 4. Application Period

Submit an application to the institution by post, FAX or Email during the period listed below.

**March 15, 2012 to May 28, 2012**

Applications will stop being accepted once the maximum number of participants (30) is reached, even if the application period has not yet ended.

## 5. Study Fees Payment Methods

Applicants will be contacted with payment details. Study fees must be transferred by no later than May 28, 2012. Applicants will be sent a participant acceptance notice by FAX or Email once payment of the study fees has been confirmed.

Starting with this year's study, we can also accept payment of study fees via credit card in addition to bank transfer. (Only Visa and MasterCard. A separate handling fee will be charged when paying by credit card.)



## 6. Cancellation Fees (For Business Hotel Plan)

Please contact the International Exchange Center for the cancellation policy for the Accommodation Exclusive Plan.

**(Cancellations made by June 4)**

100% of paid study fees will be refunded with the participant bearing any responsibility for transfer or remittance fees.

**(Cancellations made between June 5 and June 25)**

50% of paid study fees will be refunded with the participant bearing any responsibility for transfer or remittance fees.

**(Cancellations made between June 26 and July 1)**

30% of paid study fees will be refunded with the participant bearing any responsibility for transfer or remittance fees.

**(Cancellations made after July 2)**

No refunds of study fees will be provided.

## 7. Study Cancellation

If there are fewer than 15 participants by May 28, 2012 (Monday), the study will be cancelled.

In the event the study is cancelled, all paid study fees will be immediately refunded (with the institution bearing any responsibility for transfer or remittance fees).

### Field Trips

Participants will visit Universal Studios Japan, Kyoto and Osaka Castle on field trips.

Participants will go on a walking tour of Osaka Castle, the symbol of Osaka, with volunteer guides. In addition, the Kyoto trip in July is held during a special period when the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage "Gion Festival" is being held and lots of tourists are gathered from all over the world.

Participants will also experience Japan by visiting the only Asian branch of worldwide themepark "Universal Studios Japan," for what is sure to be an unforgettable experience.



### Exchange Events

Participants will team up with conversation partners to make okonomiyaki, one of Osaka's representative "B-grade gourmet" foods. Have fun learning how to make okonomiyaki and create lots of new friends during the okonomiyaki party.



### In Closing
